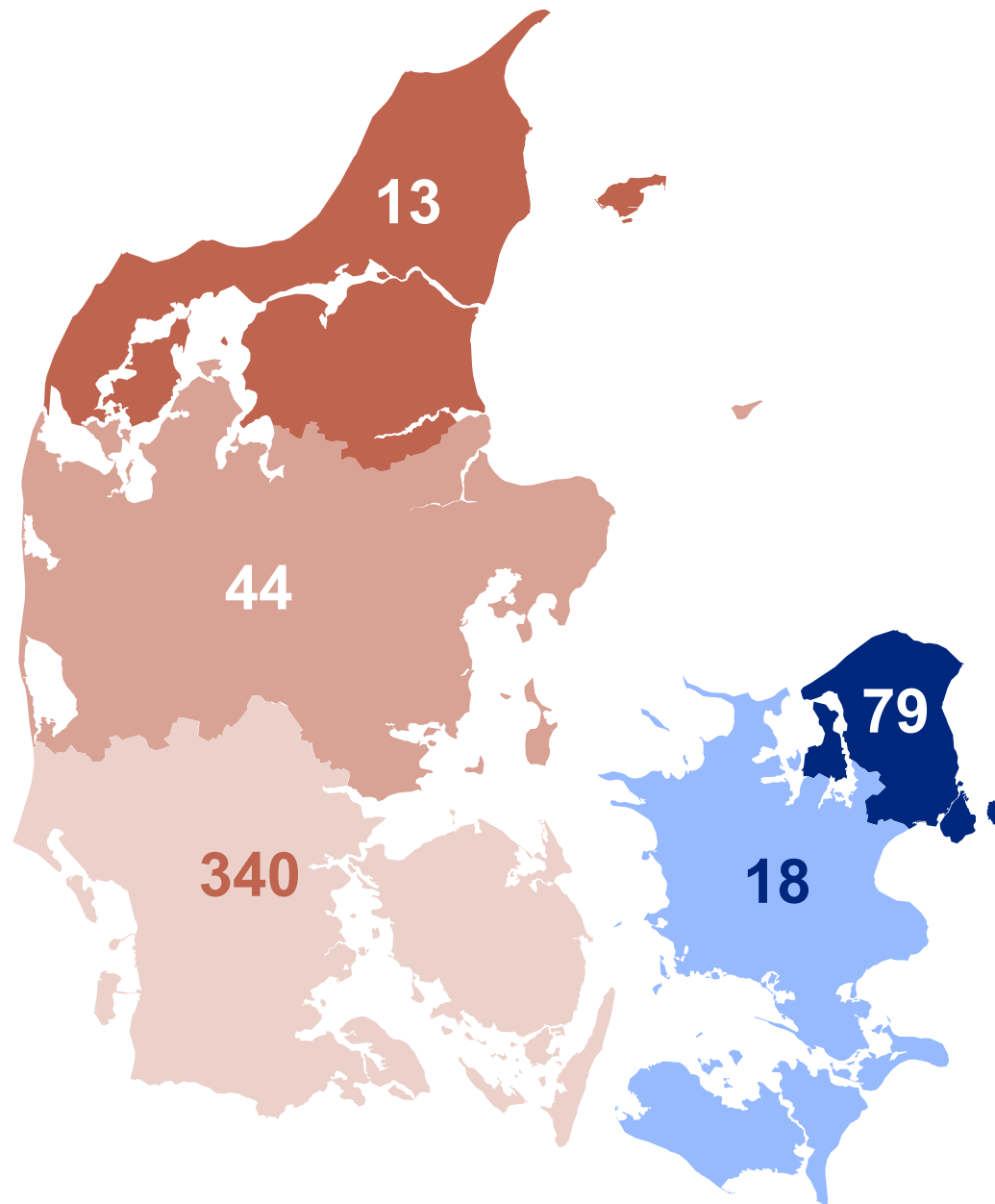

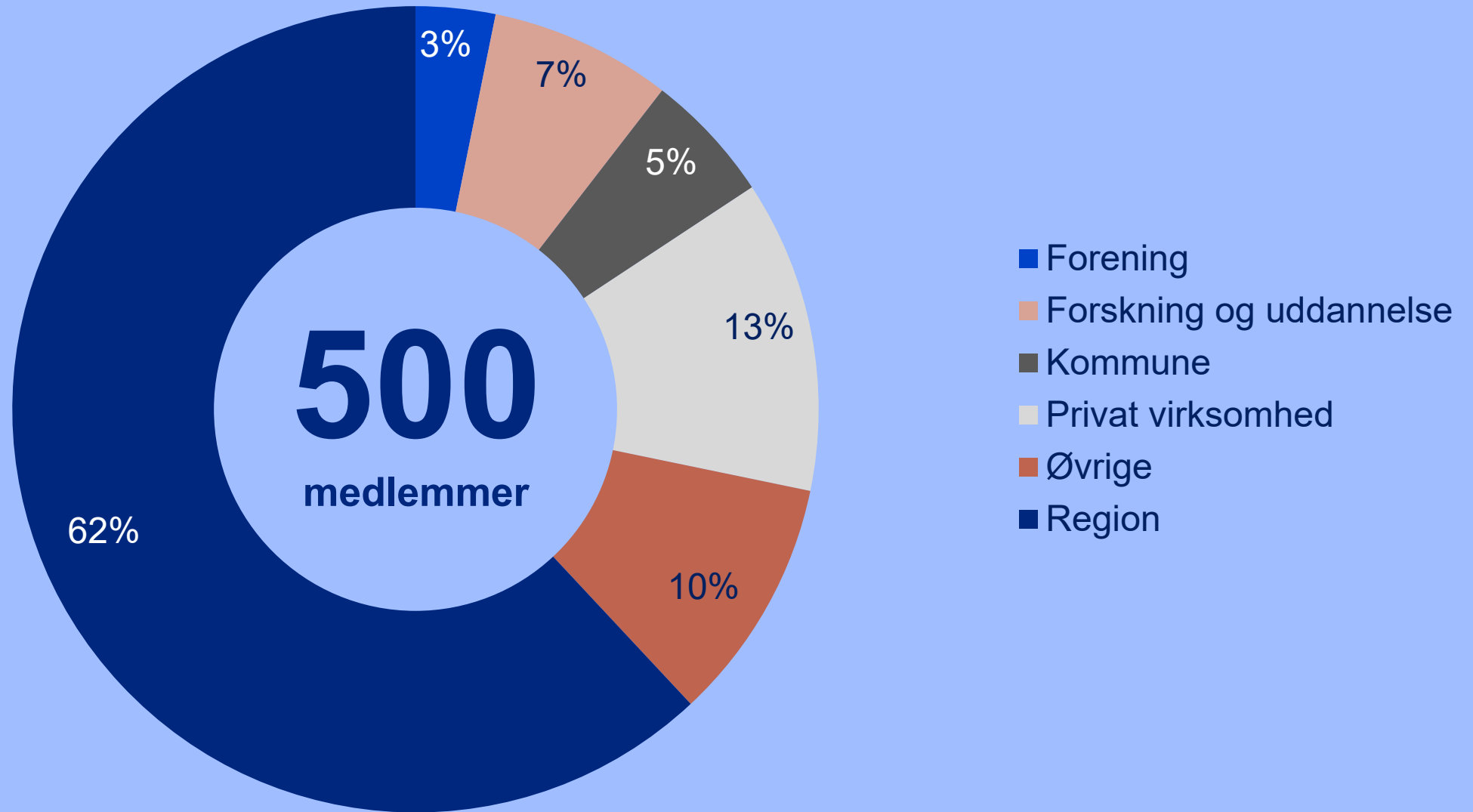

Non-communicable diseases (NCDs) are responsible for **80% of the disease burden** in EU countries

Improved health promotion and disease prevention can **reduce the prevalence** of NCDs by as much as **70%**

The UN Sustainable Development Goals

By 2030, reduce one third premature mortality from NCD through prevention and treatment and promote mental health and well-being



Aim and objectives of JA PreventNCD

Reduce the burden of cancer and other NCDs and common risk factors, both at a **personal and societal level**, and support member states by taking a **holistic, coordinated approach** to prevention.

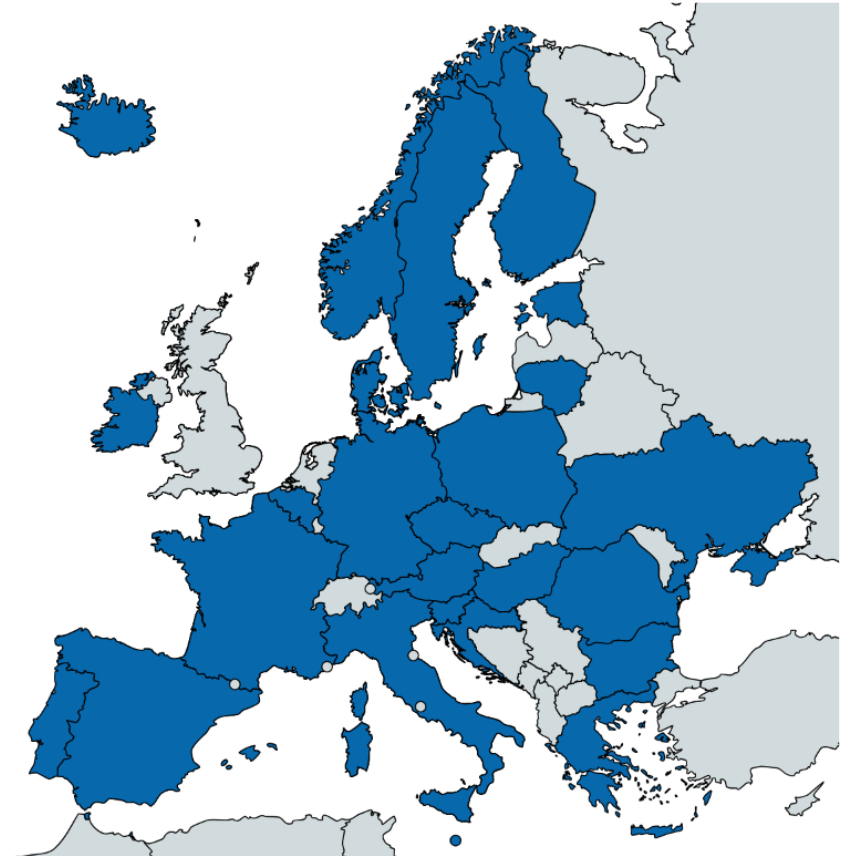

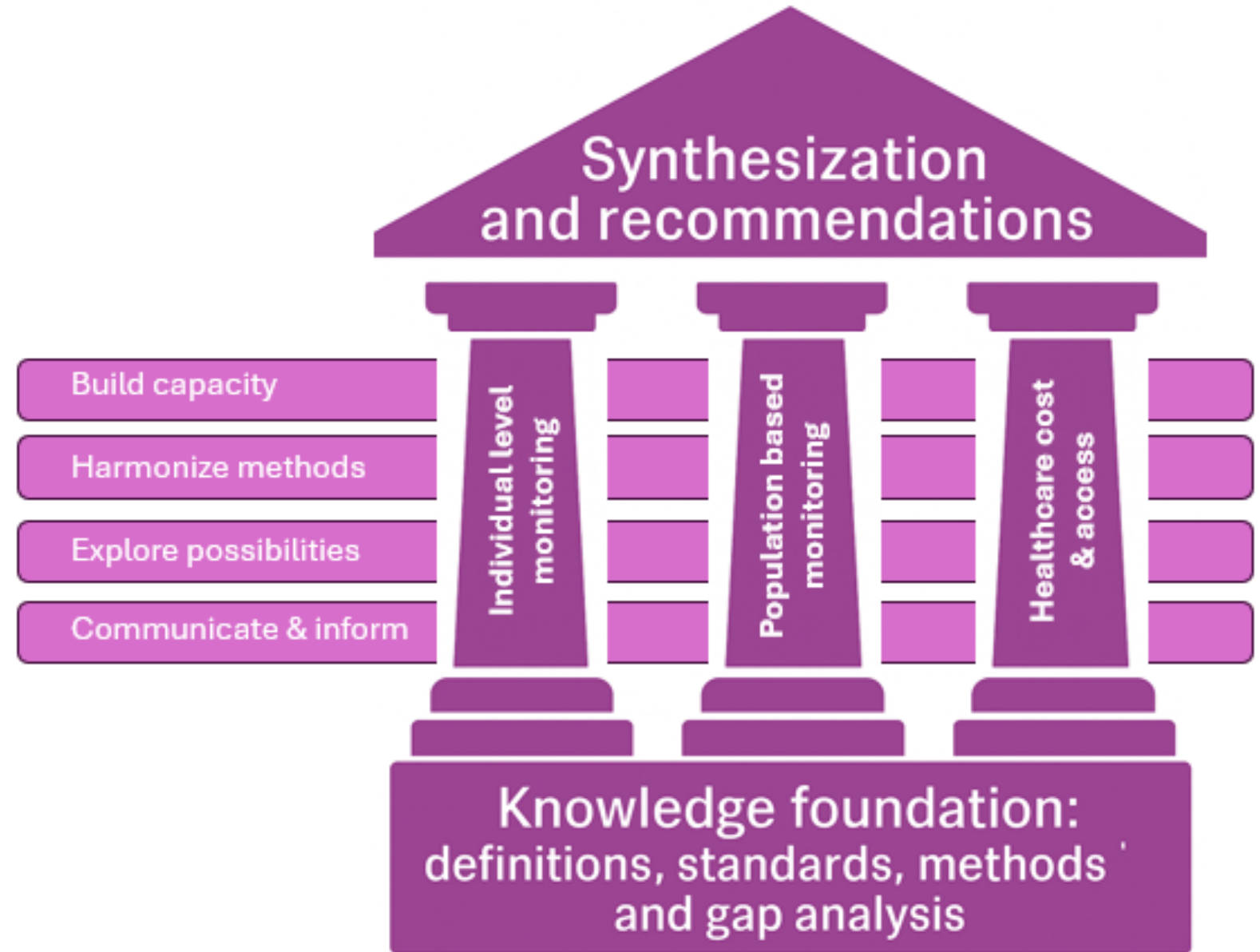

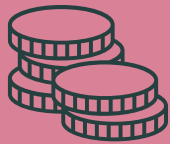
